INSTRUCTIONS MANUAL FOR BABIES' NEST

(keep available for later reference)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Adamo Babies' Nest was designed for 0–8 month old infants for sleeping, resting and playing during the day, under supervision. If you decide to have your child sleep in the babies' nest, please consult your baby's GP first, and follow the protective measures below.

Non-observance of the warnings below may lead to life threatening situations or severe physical injuries.

- It is extremely important that all persons are aware of the presence of the child in the bed.
- Always use the babies' nest on a solid, level surface.
- Make sure the babies' nest cannot fall from the surface.
- The babies' nest must at all times be placed on the middle part of the surface.
- Make sure there are no blankets or pillows near the nest since these may present a choking hazard for the baby.
- Make sure there are no blankets, canopies, pillowcases, bedclothes and any other textiles above and near the nest that the child could drag on his or her face.
- Never let the child sleep together with an adult with a sleeping disorder, under the influence of alcohol, drugs or medicaments, or with obese persons.
- The blankets and bedclothes placed above the nest can cover the baby's face or cause overheating.
- The infant may only lie in the nest on his or her back. It is not recommended to have the child sleep in the nest on his or her belly until the age of one year.
- Do not place any blankets or pillows in the nest.
- There may be no cords or ribbons near the nest, since these may pose a choking hazard for the baby.
- Never leave the baby without supervision in the nest.
- The babies' nest may only be used for infants in a connected state, closed with the zipper.
- Never let the child take the buckle, cord or Velcro closing the end of the babies' nest into his or her mouth or play with it.
- Do not expose the babies' nest to radiating heat, and make sure you observe fire protection provisions.
- When used by an older child, care should be taken not to close the end of the nest (contrary to the case when an infant uses it). This is very important to enable the child to leave the nest without difficulties, and not falling over the edges. Also, the nest should be placed on a surface low enough so that the child can come off it safely, without any help.
- It is EXPRESSLY FORBIDDEN to put the baby or child and have him or her sleep in the babies' nest in strong direct sunlight!
- The babies' nest must not be used as a carrying device. Please take the baby or child out of the nest before transferring the nest to another surface.
- To avoid the risk of accidents, do not put any toys or soft objects into the nest.
- Never leave a baby in the nest without supervision if the baby is already able to crawl.
- Please always observe the washing instructions located on the side of the nest.

WASHING AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

All parts of the nest can be cleaned.

Please remove the mattress and the filling cylinder from the case before washing. Accessories can be cleaned separately. The maximum shrinking of the textile part after washing is 4%.

It is very important to always completely dry the babies' nest to prevent mould growth. Never use the nest when it is still moist.

Never place waterproof materials on the mattress since this can cause the baby to overheat, and in case of leaking liquid, the liquid cannot leave freely.

CLEANING THE CASE

- When cleaning the product, it is not recommended to use bleachers. If it is absolutely necessary, use a cleanser instead. For disinfection, vinegar is preferred.
- The case can be washed in a washing machine, using a mild program, with lukewarm water.
- It is recommended to air-dry the case.
- To ensure long product life, please wash the case in a washing bag.

CLEANING THE MATTRESS

- The mattress can be washed by hand in lukewarm water.
- Lay it on a flat surface and air-dry it.
- Do not iron.
- It is not recommended to use a bleacher.

CLEANING THE INNER FILLING CYLINDER

- It is not necessary to wash the inner filling very often. Usually, it is enough to shake the filling well, and then vent it in the air and disinfect it.
- It is recommended to dry the cylinder in a horizontal position.
- After cleaning the cylinder, when placing it back in its case, please make sure the zipper cannot get entangled in the cylinder, because this can damage the textile.
- To prevent choking hazard, never use the inner cylinder if its case is torn.

All parts of the nest are anti-allergenic.

The covering case: 100% cotton and Oeko-TEX Standard

The filling of the cylinder: 100% polyester

The mattress: 100% polyester
